Leaving your hoses attached to the spigot during freezing months can not only cause them to freeze to the spigot, but can also cause pipes to burst and flood your home.

Maintenance Tip:

Detach all hoses from the outside spigots, and make sure to close your valves completely to prevent any water from escaping. This will help ensure that you do not have a flooding issue as the temperatures drop!
